State Representative Chuck Hopson Earns Statewide Award for Fighting Lawsuit Abuse

(Henderson, TX) Texans for Lawsuit Reform PAC today awarded State Representative Chuck Hopson the TLR Civil Justice Leadership Award for his support of a fair and predictable civil justice system in Texas. Speaking to a luncheon in Henderson, TLR PAC Chairman Richard Trabulsi said:

“Chuck has been steadfast in supporting lawsuit reforms that have strengthened the Texas economy and increased access to health care in our state. He has stood up for the best interests of Texas and House District 11 and opposed the powerful Texas Trial Lawyers Association, who push the plaintiff lawyer agenda.”

Trabulsi said Hopson’s outstanding record on civil justice reform includes his support for the landmark Omnibus Tort Reform Bill of 2003 (HB) 4 and the critically important 2005 reforms that have largely eliminated abusive asbestos litigation.
